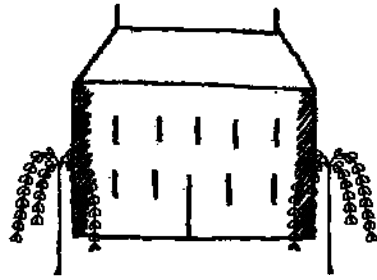

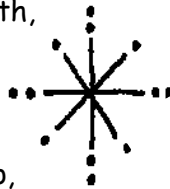

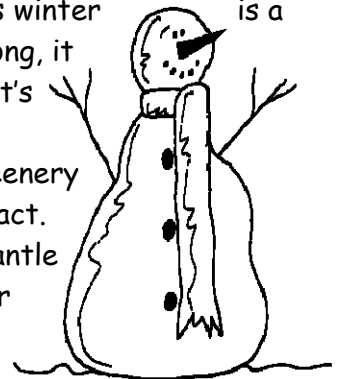

This rose revival is fresh with a touch of nostalgia, combining elements of urban design with shabby chic. The key to achieving an "urban chic" look is to pair lighter feminine styled accessories with neutral hues and darker finishes for lots of impact. For example, take our prints featuring lilacs and hydrangeas painted on white-washed wood panels, and display them on a wall painted in deep smoky taupe.
